68. VEGETABLE TOP TRAY COMPETITION

(Open to All)

This Class is for a display of three types of Vegetables from the following list of eight. The quantity required is given in brackets; Carrots (3) Cauliflowers (2) Onions (3) Peas (6 Pods) Potatoes (3) Runner Beans (6 Pods) Tomatoes (6)

All Vegetables are to be displayed for effect. The Vegetables are to be displayed within an area of 18in by 24in (45 x 60cm) without bending any part of them. No part of any exhibit may exceed the size of the tray. A tray or board measuring 18in by 24in (45 x 60cm) can be used to display the Vegetables, or the area can be simply marked out on the staging. Where the tray has a lip, the inside edge must not exceed the stated size. A black cloth is permitted, or the tray may be painted

RULES OF THE SHOW

1. Entry is open to all Competitors who can bring their Exhibits to the Show.
2. Every Exhibit must have been the property of the Exhibitor from at least 1st of June prior to the Show.
3. There is no limit to the number of entries which can be made by any Competitor in any Class
4. All Exhibits will be regarded as having been donated to the Committee for sale, except in the Pot Plant Class. Exhibitors who specially desire that any of their Exhibits be returned should place a "Not for Sale" notice securely attached to their Exhibits.
5. Any Exhibit in the Fruit Class may be cut or opened by the Judges for inspection and/or tasting, and any Competitor who refuses to permit this will be automatically disqualified.
6. The disposal of the Exhibits not sold will be at the discretion of the Committee.
7. No member of the Public will be allowed in the Tent whilst Judging is in progress.
8. Exhibits may be staged between 8 and 11 a.m. on the morning of the Show.
9. Each Exhibit must carry an Exhibitors Card, obtainable from the Flower Show Treasurer on the morning of the Show.
10. The placing of all Exhibits shall be determined by the Show Stewards whose directions Exhibitors must comply with.
11. **EXHIBITORS ARE ASKED TO PROVIDE THEIR OWN CONTAINERS.**
12. Judging will begin at 11.05 a.m. and whilst in progress only persons officially retained will be allowed to remain in the Tent.
13. An Exhibitor may be awarded more than one prize in any Class
14. The Cups and Trophies will be awarded on the following basis;
1st Prize gains 3 points, - 2nd Prize gains 2 points, - 3rd Prize gains 1 point.
15. The Decision of the Judges shall be final. Judges finding themselves in doubt about any matter shall be at liberty to consult with a small Committee appointed for the purpose. Further, this Committee shall be empowered to bring any relevant point to the Judges notice.
16. Each winner of a Cup or Trophy must sign a declaration guaranteeing to return them to the Secretary by 1st July, the following year.
17. No Exhibit may be removed from the Tent till 4 p.m. on the day of the Show. The Committee shall not be held responsible for items left after this time, and items which have been arranged to be collected later than the specified time are left entirely at the Competitors own risk.
18. It is mandatory that all Competitors and Visitors alike thoroughly enjoy their day out, and smile all day long

ATTENTION ALL COMPETITORS

Entries must be staged by 11 a.m. on the day of the Show. A fee of 10p. is charged per Entry. Please ensure that you put an Exhibitors Card, bearing your details with each Exhibit. Please collect Cash Prizes from the Flower Show Treasurer between 2 p.m. and 4 p.m. on the day of the Show.
