**HIGHLAND PONIES**

(Registered ponies only in this section. Full registered name and number must be quoted on entry form.)

1. Mare. Yeld. 4 years and over.
2. Gelding, 4 years and over.
3. Yearling. Colt, filly or gelding.
4. Filly. 2 or 3 years old.
5. Gelding. 2 or 3 years old.
6. Colt. 2 or 3 years old.
7. Stallion. 4 years and over.
8. Mare. 4 years and over, with foal at foot.
9. Foal.
10. Ridden.
11. Working pony shown in appropriate harness.

**(Ponies competing in this section may also compete in the working hunter and driving classes. Highland ponies not registered or not eligible for registration may compete in the non-registered Mountain and Moorland classes. See light horse schedule.)**

**SHETLAND PONIES**

(Registered ponies only in this section. Full registered name and number must be quoted on entry form.)

1. Mare. Yeld. 4 years old and over.
2. Gelding, 4 years and over.
3. Yearling. Colt, filly or gelding
4. Filly. 2 or 3 years old.
5. Gelding. 2 or 3 years old.
6. Colt. 2 or 3 years old.
7. Stallion. 4 years old and over.
8. Mare, 4 years old and over, with foal at foot.
9. Foal.
10. Miniature.
11. Coloured.
12. Ridden.
13. Junior handler. 8 years and under.
14. Junior handler. 9 – 16 years.

**(Ponies competing in this section may also compete in the working hunter and driving classes. Shetland ponies not registered or not eligible for registration may compete in the non-registered Mountain and Moorland classes. See light horse schedule.)**

**SPSBS AFFILIATION RULES 2010**

1. Classes must be confined to Registered Ponies. Ponies must be named on the entry form and in the catalogue if one is produced. Society rosettes must only be given to ponies registered with the Society or eligible for registration (i.e. foals)
2. Three year old fillies with foals at foot may not be shown. All foals must be a minimum of 3 weeks old on the day of the Show.
3. There must be no colts or entire males in Young Handler's classes. Children under 14 years old may not show colts (excluding foals) or entire males in In hand classes. Children under 11 years old on the day of the show may not show entire males in ridden classes. In the interests of safety, hard hats must be worn by all handlers aged 14 years or under in In hand classes. Hard hats must be worn by all exhibitors, irrespective of age, in ridden classes. In ridden classes, if a rider falls off at any time whilst riding in the ring, both pony and rider must leave the ring, rider dismounted, and take no further part.
