

Silver Quaich presented by the late Mr J Steven in memory of Mrs Joyce Steven, Fload, to the exhibitor of the most outstanding exhibit in the Baking Section.

Silver Challenge Trophy presented by the late Mrs Roswell Miller, Skibo, to the exhibitor gaining most points in the Knitting & Sewing Section.

**Canmore Trophy** presented by Duncan MacKay, Canmore, to the exhibitor with most points in the Junior Section 3 - 6 years.

#### RULES OF COMPETITION

Please read the schedule carefully, in particular with regard to entry size.

The competition is OPEN.

Each exhibit must be the work of the person exhibiting and must not have been exhibited at a previous Sutherland Agricultural Show.

There is no limit to the number of entries in each section.

ENTRY FEES:- 50p per item. Junior entries are FREE.

While every care will be taken of exhibits during the time of the exhibition, such exhibits shall be entirely at the exhibitor's own risk. Exhibitors will be solely responsible for the delivery and removal of their exhibits.

Competition labels must be securely attached to the exhibits. Any exhibits without a name and address will be disqualified.

Points for all sections shall be as follows:-4 points for 1st place; 3 points for 2nd place; 2 points for 3rd place; 1 point for Highly Commended.

Entries must be in the Food & Craft Marquee by 9.30am. Entries must be removed after 4:00pm. Handicraft entries DO NOT mean free entry to the Showground.

Prize money will be given out in the Food & Craft Marquee between 4 & 4:30pm. Prize money as follows:- 1st - £3.00; 2nd - £2.00; 3rd -£1.00. All prize money must be collected on show day.
